Dear KLES community,

I wish you all a happy and safe winter break! Here is the KLES PTA news:

Our next KLES PTA meeting will be Tuesday, January 20 from 6 pm to 7 pm in the library. The Accountability meeting will take place immediately after. Babysitting and dinner will be provided free of charge for both meetings. We are an active, welcoming, diverse group. I hope you can join us.

Our January meeting will feature a special presentation on preventing illicit drug use among minors. KLES PTA is proud to present Lynn Riemer, president of ACT on Drugs, Inc., has a regional and National reputation as a speaker, trainer, and advocate on the issues related to substance abuse. As an experienced chemist and prior member of the North Metro Drug Task Force in Colorado, her experience brings a real, personal, and vivid face to the issues presented by illicit drug use. Over the past 11 years, Lynn has spoken regularly with students, community child advocacy groups, industrial and professional groups, and employees of local and State governmental agencies about drug awareness, recognition, and prevention. Her presentations cover all abused-substances, including legal and illegal drugs or plant material, and synthetic "designer drugs". Lynn also targets methamphetamine including information on recognizing in-home clandestine "meth-labs" and discusses the dangers these laboratories present to children living in the homes and the devastating and dangerous effects these "meth-labs" have on the home and the community.

Lynn's subject knowledge and experience, along with her ability to transfer this knowledge in an captivating and dynamic manner, make her a sought-after person for educating children, families, and communities on the issues and hazards of illicit drug use and substance abuse.

After School Activities Mrs. Runyan will offer two classes after winter break. The first class will be making ceramic bowls/boxes using a coil slab, or pinch methods. The dates for this class will be January 13 and 20 from 2:45-3:45. This class is open to all students K-6. There is a limit of 20 students for this class. The cost for this class will be \$3.00, due to Mrs. Runyan on the first day of class. Please see the flyer in your Friday folder for more information.

Mrs. Runyan's second class will be Legos for boys. This class is open to all boys in grades K-6. The dates for this class will be February 3 and 10 from 2:45-3:45.
